#### INTRODUCTION

"மதிநுட்பம் நூலோடு உடையார்க்கு அதிநுட்பம் யாவுள முன்நிற் பவை".

(அதிகாரம் 64, குறள் 636)

"What (contrivances) are there so acute as to resist those who possess natural acuteness in addition to learning?"

Public Works Department plays a very important role in the development of building infrastructure of various Government departments in the State. This department delivers its prime all Government departments service to in constructing buildings, special structures, their maintenance undertaking and aivina technical expertise.

Public Works Department has been functioning as the parent department for all the engineering departments since 1858. The department with its engineering construction expertise rendering services to the public by developing State infrastructure for the past 165 years.

According to the requirements of various Government departments, Public Works Department constructs public buildings with planning and design and ensuring the soundness of the buildings within the strategic policy and budgetary control of the Government and expedite the construction of buildings to cater to the needs of the public.

Conserving our heritage of historical and cultural values by carrying out renovation and restoration works of the monuments, memorials and heritage buildings is one of the significant activities of the Public Works Department.

Being a part of growth of the State's economy, Public Works Department is constantly striving to make innovations in building material technology and construction activities for creating sound capital assets and paving way for sustainable development.

Separate Circles and Divisions were functioning in Public Works Department to carry out construction works of Health Department. Due to non-availability of Executive Engineer posts in the districts of Chengalpattu, Ranipet, Tirupathur,

Kallakurichi, Tiruppur, Tenkasi, Sivagangai and Tiruvarur, there was a delay in supervising the works. In order to overcome this, Medical Works Circles have been integrated with other Circles to have an Executive Engineer / Division in each district and the supervising works are being implemented effectively. The proposals for strengthening of Heritage wing, Architect wing and Quality Control Division are under consideration of the Government.

A new Special Secretary to Government post in the level of Chief Engineer in Secretariat and a new Chief Engineer post for Chennai Region in Public Works Department have been created. A new Deputy Chief Engineer (Electrical) post has been created in the office of the Engineer-in-Chief, Public Works Department.

#### **1.0. OBJECTIVES**

Public Works Department creates long lasting capital assets for Government departments by implementing innovative methodologies to obtain safety, while ensuring economical and optimal utilization of resources through the united efforts of various wings of this Department viz., Architecture, Planning and Design, Construction and Maintenance, Electrical, Quality Control, Public Works Staff Training Institute and Directorate of Boilers.

Accordingly, the objective of the Public Works Department is adding pride to the Government to complete the works undertaken within the stipulated period of time as assured with quality.

#### 2.0. MISSION

Creation of capital assets in the shape of building infrastructure and its maintenance which is the prime objective of the Department.

Heading towards e-Governance initiatives such as end to end computerization for better administration and transparency.

Research in the Material Technology and Construction Methodologies by using alternate materials for optimum utilization of resources, safety and to prevent environmental degradation.

Preserving the historical and cultural values by restoration, renovation and conservation of heritage buildings and monuments.

Making a secure civil and electrical arrangement in connection with the VVIP visits and important Government events.

#### 3.0. VISION

To make Tamil Nadu self-reliant by improving building infrastructure of the State to cater to the needs of people of the State.

The entire department activities for an entrusted construction work from commencement to completion are being computerized with the assistance of Tamil Nadu e-Governance Agency. The phases of workflow will be updated from the site and verified by the competent authority for improving the administrative efficiency.

Ensuring transparency and better governance through complete digitalization and providing seamless information about the activities of Government to the people.

#### 4.0 SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

The 17 Sustainable Development Goals and 169 targets are part of the Sustainable Development Goals-2030 Agenda adopted by 193 Member States at the United Nations General Assembly Summit. This department deals with construction and maintenance of Government buildings.

## Two targets 9.1 and 11.4 for Public Works Department

**Target 9.1:** Develop quality, reliable sustainable and resilient infrastructure, including regional and transborder infrastructure, to support economic development and human well being, with a focus on affordable and equitable access for all.

(i) Buildings constructed by the department are in line with the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015-2030,

which looks after inclusion of resource efficiency, mitigation and adaptation to climate change and resilience to disasters.

(ii) To reduce the environment degradation, new methodologies have been adapted by the Tamizhaga Arasu Building Research Station, Public Works Department such as using crushed stone sand in major infrastructure projects instead of River Sand.

**Target 11.4 :** To strengthen efforts to protect and safeguard the World's cultural and natural heritage.

In order to preserve and conserve Heritage Structures, a separate Division viz., Building Centre and Conservation Division, Chennai was formed in the year 2017 by Public Works Department.

The Public Works Department is constantly working towards accomplishment of Sustainable Development Goals.

#### **5.0. WINGS OF PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT 5.1. Architect wing**

From the year 1984, the Architect wing in Public Works Department (upgraded to Office of

the Chief Architect) is functioning under the control of Chief Architect.

Preliminary drawings, detailed plans, elevations & cross sections for construction of buildings, considering the utility aspects such as office, educational, medical and residential purposes, etc., are evolved by the Architect wing as per the standard norms. It also includes rendering of floor plan, site plan, the elevation and isometric views apart from 2D and 3D views.

The Digital 3D modeling and new form of rendered images enables the user department to have a clear understanding about the end result of the construction.

The Architect wing uses high speed software programs such as Auto CAD, Revit, 3dsMax and Sketchup to provide new innovative service of digital media.

The Architect wing continue to keep adapting all latest software relating to digital 3D design to keep pace with technology changes and to stay in the forefront for providing better services to all Government departments.

#### 5.2 Planning and Designs Circle

The prime role of Planning and Designs circle is evolving structural design and drawings as per the requirements of the user departments and construction of the Government buildings are executed with load bearing using latest technology in compliance with the codes of Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS).

This wing develops structural designs for all Government buildings like Medical College and Hospital buildings, Collectorate buildings, Memorials, Court buildings, Government guest houses, Monuments, Multi-storeyed residential buildings etc.

To carry out effective and quality construction, this wing issues Technical circulars to guide the Engineers of Public Works Department.

This wing issues Structural Soundness Certificate for new and old Cinema Theatres more than 50 years old and issuing Structural Stability certificate to the Public Buildings such as Schools, Cultural Centres, Cinema Theatres, Colleges, etc.




#### 5.3. Tamizhaga Arasu Buildings Research Station

Tamizhaga Arasu Building Research Station is involved in assessing the quality of various construction materials (Civil & Electrical) such as steel, cement, paint, doors, windows, PVC pipes, tiles, electrical wires, switches, lights, conduit pipes, etc., and other special / innovative types of construction materials introduced then and there in the market with latest technologies through the Public Works Department Assessment Committee which comprise of technical experts from the various Government Institutions and Indian departments such as Institute of Technology, Bureau of Indian Standards, Anna University, etc and facilitate the usage of such materials for various building construction construction activities in private and Government departments in Tamil Nadu.

Technical Training Programmes to Assistant Engineers, Junior Engineers and Assistant Executive Engineers are being conducted every year to enhance the technical skills and for the up-gradation of knowledge to meet the present

day needs in the construction industry by engaging experts from various Organizations / Institutions / Department Engineers.

This wing provides Technical Consultancy services to various private organizations, Government departments, etc.

Laboratory testing for quality in construction materials such as cement, steel, concrete etc., are being conducted in the laboratory established in Tharamani, Chennai.

#### 5.4 Building Center and Conservation Division

specialised wing of Public Works Α called "Building Department Center and Division" Conservation is functioning to rehabilitate, restore and conserve the heritage structures located in Tamil Nadu. Many valuable heritage buildings like Kalasa Mahal at Chepauk, Egmore Court building, Egmore Museum, Madras High Court and Public Works Department Chief Engineer's office at Chepauk are already restored by Public Works Department. Humayun Mahal at Chepauk, Chennai known for its architectural

being rehabilitated value is now bv this department. This division has also undertaken the restoration of old heritage buildings like Deputy Inspector General of Registration office at Rajaji Salai, Kuthiraivandi Court building at Coimbatore, Old Labour Court building at Salem, Old Collectorate building (Rani Mangammal Palace) at Trichy, Governor Palace at Coimbatore (Old Forest Department Office), Kodaikanal Kohinoor Sheik Abdullah Bungalow and the Madras University building.

#### 5.5 Construction and Maintenance Wing

The Construction and Maintenance wing of Public Works Department is a main execution functioning with 43 Divisions having wina jurisdiction throughout the State. The prime role and Maintenance wing of Construction is execution of the project as per the architect plan prepared by the Chief Architect and also structural drawing prepared by Planning and Designs Circle. Tt involves supervision and inspection of construction works carried out by contractors, preventing deviation of the plan specified in the contract by measuring the work periodically and

are well accounted in the measurement book and maintaining the register for recording of expenditure incurred.

#### 5.6 Electrical Wing

The objective of Electrical Wing is to make the buildings / structures constructed by Public Works Department functional and aesthetic by adopting modern technologies. 8 Electrical Divisions are functioning throughout the State.

All internal and external electrification works of buildings including special type of electrical works such as Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC), Variable Refrigerant Flow Air Conditioning, Lift, Generator, Transformer, Public address System, Intercom, Video Conferencing, Closed Circuit Television and Fire alarm arrangements, Special lighting arrangements to the monuments and memorials, etc. are being exemplarily executed for more than 54 years.

Electrical works and Electrical maintenance works in all Government buildings are being executed in a fool-proof manner. Electrical Wing in Public Works Department acts in compliance with Tamil Nadu Electricity Act & Central Electricity Authority Regulations.

Special attention is being given for provision of barrier-free environment as per the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

#### 5.7 Quality Control Divisions

Quality Control Divisions facilitate the process of establishing a centralized quality control system which ensures uniformity in quality of the buildings.

Quality Control Divisions are responsible for regular inspection of the construction sites to ensure that the execution of project meets the standards specified in the contract.

Three Quality Control Divisions are functioning at Chennai, Madurai and Coimbatore under the control of Executive Engineer.

#### 5.8 Public Works Staff Training Institute

Public Works Staff Training Institute, Tiruchirappalli provides periodical training to the Engineers, Technical Staff and Ministerial Staff of the Public Works Department to make them updated to modern technologies and Government Policies.

In the year 2022-2023, 160 numbers of Ministerial staff and 234 numbers of technical staff are benefitted by the trainings conducted by the Public Works Staff Training Institute.

The one-day training programme on "Trending construction techniques and Know-how" for Engineers and Architects of Public Works Department at Chennai on 17.03.2023 was inaugurated by Hon'ble Minister for Public Works Department.

#### 5.9 Directorate of Boilers

The Director of Boilers ensures the safe Design of the Boilers and Boiler Components as per the provision of the Boilers Act, 1923 and the Boilers Regulations, 1950.

Approval to be obtained from the Director of Boilers for the manufacturing units for Boilers and Boiler Components, Valves, Fittings, Castings, Forgings, Electrodes and Non-Destructive Testing Firms and Boilers Repairers / Erectors. The Director of Boilers as an Inspecting Authority is responsible for the certification of Boilers and Boiler Components during manufacturing and as Registering Authority he is responsible for the Registration of new boilers in Tamil Nadu. He also represents Tamil Nadu Government as a Member in Central Boilers Board.

The Director of Boilers as Chairman of Board of Examination conducts the Boiler Operation Engineers examinations per the as Boiler Operation Engineers Rules, 2011 and the Boiler Attendants Examination as per the Boiler Attendants Rules, 2011 framed by Central Boiler is the Competent Authority for Board. He conducting welder qualification test in different types of welding processes and certifies the welders.

Deputy Directors of Boilers inspect the boilers with Heating Surface Area above  $465 \text{ m}^2$  and Senior Assistant Directors of Boilers inspect the Boilers with Heating Surface Area upto  $465 \text{ m}^2$ .

#### **6.0 SERVICES**

#### 6.1 Standard Schedule of Rates

The Standard Schedule of Rates is prepared every year based on the prevailing local market rate by the Schedule of Rates Committee. It is used in the preparation of Estimates (only basic rates) for the construction of all Government buildings. This Standard Schedule of Rates is being used by the Engineering departments such as Water Resources Department, Highways Department, Tamil Nadu Housing Board, Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board, Greater Chennai Corporation and other Government Organisations.

The Schedule of Rates for the year 2022-2023 includes the rates of Pre-fabricated Structures / Precast Structures which are manufactured by using modern technology to speed up the work in the construction sector.

#### 6.2 Plinth Area Rate

Plinth Area Rate is the approximate cost per square meter of the build-up area. Plinth Area Rate is prepared based on the Standard Schedule of Rates. It is used in the preparation of rough cost estimates per square meter for construction of buildings. Plinth Area Rate is published by the Public Works Department and used by all Engineering Departments in Government.

This Plinth Area Rates are used for fixing Reasonableness Rent and for the purpose of fixing Stamp Duty by the Registration Department.

#### 6.3 Structural Stability Certificate

Public Works Department issues Structural Stability Certificate for various public buildings such as Schools, Colleges, Cinema Theatres, etc.

#### 6.4 Rent Reasonableness Certificate

Public Works Department issues Rent Reasonableness Certificate for the Government Offices functioning in the private buildings.

#### 6.5 Technical Guidance

Public Works Department imparts technical guidance and internship to the students from various Engineering Colleges to enrich their technical knowledge and career growth.



The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu inaugurated the newly constructed Tirupathur District Collectorate Master Plan Complex on 29.06.2022 and planted the saplings in the complex.

#### 6.6 Recommendation for Private Panel of Engineers at District Level

Based on the approval of the Board of Engineers of Public Works Department, necessary recommendation is issued to District Collector for registering in the panel of private practicing Engineers in the district concerned for rendering private Engineering services.

#### 6.7 Circuit Houses and Inspection Bungalows

For the comfortable stay of VVIPs/VIPs and Government Officials during site inspection and for tourists stay, 65 Inspection Bungalows, 61 Circuit Houses and Guest Houses all over Tamil Nadu are constructed and maintained by Public Works Department.

#### 6.8 Technical Consultancy Services

Providing technical consultancy services such as preparation of structural design & drawings, detailed estimates received from departments or agencies such as Hindu Religious & Charitable Endowments, Tourism Department, Museum Department, etc.

#### 6.9 Government Staff Quarters

Construction of 190 'B' type quarters at an estimate cost of Rs.88.49 Crore are in progress. Construction of new multi-storied building consisting of 190 'C Type' quarters at Todhunter Nagar, Saidapet at an estimate cost of Rs.99.98 Crore will be taken up.

#### 6.10 Construction and Maintenance of Tamil Nadu House, New Delhi

Tamil Nadu House in New Delhi is a prestigious Guest House of the Government of Tamil Nadu, providing boarding, lodging and transport facilities to the State Guests, Hon'ble Ministers, Public Representatives and Government Officials.

Tamil Nadu House has 2 premises and both are located in the diplomatic area of Chanakyapuri first New Delhi. The Guest House, in "Vaigai-Tamil Nadu House" was built in the year 1962 on a piece of land measuring about 1.76 No.6 Kautilya Marg, acres at Chanakyapuri. It was originally called as 'Madras House'. In order to accommodate the increasing

number of guests, another Block was constructed in the year 1976.

An additional Guest House named as "Podhigai – Tamil Nadu House" was constructed in a plot of land measuring about 1.97 acres at No.9 Tikendrajit Marg, Chanakyapuri and was inaugurated on 16.09.2004.

In order to upgrade Tamil Nadu Vaigai Illam by constructing new buildings for which estimates are prepared. The works will be taken up shortly.

#### 6.11 Keezhadi Museum

The Tamil Nadu Archaeology Department has unearthed thousands of Archaeological materials by Keezhadi and Kondhagai excavation exhibiting the existence of ancient urban civilization and industrial area depicting the Tamil culture and antiquity.

Public Works Department has completed the construction of a museum with world-class modern facilities to display the artifacts found in the Keezhadi and Kondhagai excavations at a cost of Rs.18.43 crore, with total built up area of 31,000 square feet and the museum has been

inaugurated by the Hon'ble Tamil Nadu Chief Minister on 05.03.2023.

The museum building has been provided with courtyards, porches and halls to express the artistry of the houses in the area.

#### 6.12 Rain Water Harvesting

Realising the significance of rain water harvesting as mentioned in the above Thirukkural, intensive steps are taken by the Public Works Department to promote rainwater harvesting by providing necessary structure in all Government buildings. Different types of arrangements are adopted depending on different sites and soil conditions.

Rain Water Harvesting Structures have been constructed in all existing Government buildings by this department. It is also made mandatory to include provision for rain water harvesting structures in the estimate for newly proposed buildings.



The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu inaugurated the Keezhadi Museum at Konthagai Village, Thirupuvanam Taluk in Sivagangai District on 05.03.2023.

The existing rain water harvesting structures are subjected to periodic inspection and maintenance to ensure the quality of structures before the monsoon for effective rain water harvesting.

#### 6.13 Disaster Management

Disaster Management involves engineering intervention in buildings and structures to make them strong enough to withstand natural hazards so that the exposure of the society to hazard situation could be avoided or minimized.

Disaster Risk Reduction during the monsoon, cyclone period is a major challenge necessitating meticulous planning and extensive preparedness at 3 stages viz., pre-disaster, during disaster and post-disaster.

Public Works Department provides the framework for responding to disasters such as cyclone, flood inside building and preparedness for evacuation.

Preparedness includes intensive survey and inspection of all Government campus and

Government buildings maintained by the Public Works Department. Ensuring the power backup arrangements specifically to Intensive Care Units in Government hospitals, adequate safety measures in Government buildings to prevent seepage of water, stability of roof terrace and buildings, identifying weak and improving of dilapidated structures then and there.

#### 6.14 Natural Disasters Mitigation Measures

Every building is planned, designed, constructed, equipped, maintained and operated so as to provide not only adequate comfort to the occupants but also to take meticulous care to avoid undue danger to the life and safety of the occupants from Fire, Earthquake, Tsunami, Cyclone, Flood and other hazards.

The Government buildings are constructed based on the Codes published by the Bureau of Indian Standards including the National Building Code, 2016. Public Works Department ensures the stability of the buildings and structures, in design and construction with respect to fire, earthquake, tsunami, cyclone, flood and other natural hazards.

## 6.15 Creation of Barrier Free Environment for the Differently Abled Persons

In compliance of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, Public Works Department works for improving the accessibility and barrier free construction for Differently Abled Persons by building barrier free environment in construction and maintenance works in all categories of buildings and facilities used by the public by making them accessible and functional for Differently Abled Persons following the general guidelines and space standards for barrier free built-up environment.

The objective of barrier free design is to provide an environment that supports the independent functioning of individual so that they can get to participate without assistance in everyday activities.

Provision of Signage at the junction of all routes, key destinations such as ramps, doors, toilets, drinking water facility, etc. Provision of tactile tiles to identify the doors, Anti-skid tiles in ramps and toilets and hand rails inside the toilets. Provision of hand rails inside the lifts, audio device telling which floor the car has reached and whether the door of the car is either open or close. In the lift buttons Braille raised letters are being embossed for easy operation by the visually challenged persons.

All polling booths are being set up with ramp to provide barrier free environment to the differently abled to cast their vote during the election.

## 6.16 Improving Medical Infrastructure to help fighting the Covid-19 Pandemic

Public Works Department has played a significant role during the COVID 19 Pandemic period by creation of required infrastructure for the treatment of Covid-19 Patients.

Oxygen pipeline installation and related works for providing additional beds in Corona wards were completed by Public Works Department in the shortest possible time.

Isolated wards were created with the essential facilities, amenities to Doctors and

Paramedical staff, guide boards and barrier fences were provided.

Out of 44,098 beds for corona patients, 37,589 beds have been provided with oxygen facility in all the Medical College Hospitals, District Head Quarters Hospitals and Primary Health Centres in Tamil Nadu in a short period of time by the Public Works Department.

Under Tamil Nadu Emergency COVID Rehabilitation Project-2, 2096 ICU Beds with Oxygen facilities were provided with an estimated cost of Rs.60.78 Crores in 50 Government Hospitals, 37 District Head Quarters Hospitals and 116 Sub District Hospitals.

Foundation stone was laid by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 23.05.2021 for upgrading the Periyar Nagar Government Peripheral Hospital in the Kolathur Constituency of Chennai to a 300 bedded COVID Hospital and the work was completed at an estimated cost of Rs.19.42 Crore and inaugurated on 13.08.2021 by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu.

#### 7.0 CONSERVATION, RENOVATION AND RESTORATION OF HERITAGE BUILDINGS

Preservation of Heritage Buildings with Historical, Architecture, Cultural & Aesthetic Values has been significant for the State.

The Building Center and Conservation Division of Public Works Department is executing conservation, renovation and restoration of heritage buildings in the best manner without altering their antiquity.

Heritage buildings such as Kalasa Mahal Building in Chepauk, Egmore Court Building and Museum Building, the Madras High Court Building and the Public Works Department Headquarters have already been renovated by the Public Works Department.

Renovation Works are in progress at Humayun Mahal in Chepauk, University of Madras Building, Deputy Inspector General of Registration Office Building in Rajaji Road and Government Central Press at Mint Street in Chennai, Governor's House and Kuthiraivandi Court Building at Coimbatore, Old Labour Court Building

at Salem, Old District Collector's Office (Rani Mangammal Palace) at Tiruchirappalli and Kohinoor Sheik Abdullah Bungalow at Kodaikanal.

Conservation, renovation and restoration works of 17 heritage buildings at a cost of Rs.103.74 crore in various districts will be taken up for implementation by the Public Works Department.

# 8.0. CRUSHED STONE SAND (COMMONLY KNOWN AS M-SAND)

The M-Sand / crushed stone sand is used as an alternative to river sand in construction works.

The quality of M-Sand / crushed stone sand is approved by the Technical Assessment Committee based on the test results and regulations of the required machinery and samples. At present 412 M-sand Manufacturing companies obtained Product Quality Approval Certificate for the quality of M-sand from the Chairman, Technical Assessment Committee and the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department, Chennai.

## M-Sand / Crushed Stone Sand Policy, 2023

Tamil Nadu M-Sand Policy, 2023 has been released by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 9.3.2023 to regulate the manufacturing of M-Sand / Crushed Sand.

In this Policy, the features regarding quality of the M-Sand used as an alternative for the river sand, the manufacturing methods of M-Sand and guidelines for regulating the industries manufacturing M-Sand are included.

#### The features relating to Public Works Department in the Policy:-

- All the M-Sand / Crushed Sand manufacturers shall mandatorily obtain BIS certification for their products.
- All the M-Sand / Crushed Sand manufacturers shall obtain Product Approval Certificate issued from the Public Works Department for compliance of BIS Code provisions.
- All existing M-Sand / Crushed Sand Manufacturing units shall be provided with a one-time offer to convert to Vertical Shaft Impactor or such other equivalent advanced technologies enhancing the quality of

M-Sand or Crushed Sand produced and get themselves registered under the Tamil Nadu Prevention of Illegal Mining, Transportation and Storage of Minerals and Mineral Dealers Rules, 2011 within such period as may be prescribed by the Department of Geology and Mining / Public Works Department.

- / Crushed the M-Sand Sand • Manufacturers shall mandatorily establish a quality testing laboratory at their crusher premises and randomly check the quality of the M-Sand / Crushed Sand produced by them every day and maintain registers for the quality checks with details of all the parameters as per the BIS Standards in respect of the Sample tested. Such registers will be verified by the officers of the Department of Geology & Mining and Public Works Department.
- six months, all the M-Sand / Once in ٠ Crushed Sand Manufacturers shall mandatorily conduct Quality tests for the product as well as for wash water at the National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL) certified / Public Works Department / Department of Geology Mining and / University Laboratories and submit the report to the Public Works Department / Department of

Geology and Mining / Pollution Control Board.

 Officers of the Public Works Department / Department of Geology and Mining will be entrusted to conduct periodical checks to verify the quality of the product.

## 9.0. HON'BLE CHIEF MINISTER'S ANNOUNCEMENTS / ICONIC PROJECTS

#### 9.1. MUTHAMIZH ARIGNAR DR.KALAIGNAR MEMORIAL LIBRARY

As per the requirements of the Directorate of Public Libraries, the estimate at a cost of Rs.114 crore for the construction of "Kalaignar Memorial Library" at Madurai has been prepared and the work of the construction of magnificent library building having an extent of 2,00,250 square feet with the ground floor and six floors is nearing completion.

To create a good learning environment with modern technology for all sections of the community, the library will have a variety of sections such as Rare Books Section, Competitive Exam Books Section, and Children Books Section, Digital Library, Sections for the visuallychallenged and the differently-abled. Also, facilities such as elevators, escalators, and ramps make it easy for the elderly, children, and the disabled to access all floors of the Library building.

#### 9.2. ANNA CENTENARY LIBRARY

The Anna Centenary Library is a globally acclaimed and South Asia's largest Library of international standards with modern facilities to cater ordinary, poor students and it is also provided with Braille section for visually-impaired. The foundation stone for the Anna Centenary Library was laid by the former Hon'ble Chief Minister Muthamizh Arignar Dr.Kalaignar on 16.08.2008 at Kotturpuram, Chennai. Accordingly, the construction work had been completed by Public Works Department and put in to use for public.

The renovation and restoration of this library building has been taken up as per the orders of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu at an estimate cost of Rs.32.48 crore and the works have been completed.

## 9.3. MEMORIAL FOR MUTHAMIZH ARIGNAR KALAIGNAR

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 24.08.2021 announced that a memorial will be constructed for former Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu Muthamizh Arignar Kalaignar M.Karunanidhi. Accordingly, the work of construction of memorial at an area of 2.21 acre in the Perarignar Anna Memorial campus at Kamarajar Salai, Chennai at a cost of Rs.39 Crore is under progress.

#### 9.4. RENOVATION OF VALLUVAR KOTTAM, CHENNAI

The Valluvar Kottam has been created by the then Chief Minister Muthamizh Arignar Kalaignar during the year 1974-1976 reflecting the Dravidian Architecture.
